

NEW CREATION JIU JITSU CODE OF CONDUCT

New Creation Jiu Jitsu (NCJJ) is founded on God, who changes lives and has given us a guide (The Bible) for living a full life. Our program is dedicated to the spiritual growth and moral character building of each individual that participates in NCJJ. Our approach to Jiu Jitsu is to be diligent and disciplined in our spiritual strengthening and physical training. For this reason, we begin each class teaching through the Bible to build up our relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Second, we learn and practice the self-defense art and techniques of Jiu Jitsu.

The four pillars of our program are established in our code of conduct, which is represented in the acronym **R.O.L.L. – Respect, Order, Leadership and Love**. These are the guiding principles that have an active influence in our leaders and students as we strive to live by them.

RESPECT We have a high regard and reverence for God and His Word first and foremost. In living a life that honors God and applies what is taught in the Bible; we will show careful consideration for people, property and authority.

- Being considerate of other’s time. I will be prompt to classes and events; calling and/or texting to notify leader(s) of absence or tardiness. *NOTE: Ten (10) minutes after class/events end, NCJJ leaders are no longer responsible for students, with the exception of those being dropped off by leaders.*
- Showing kindness in greeting others and being respectful in the closing lineup bow.
- Giving the instructor and leaders my full attention without being disruptive. *NOTE: Student’s cell phones will be collected at the beginning of each class to help eliminate distractions. Parents may contact leaders during class in the event of an emergency.*
- Reserving bathroom breaks for before and after class unless given permission from the instructor.
- Refraining from inappropriate use of language and physical touch.
- Caring for church facilities, belongings and NCJJ equipment.

ORDER

- Being prepared with sportswear, water and Bible.
- Promoting a safe environment by removing all jewelry and/or items that could cause injury or damage NCJJ equipment.

- Following the ranking system in the closing lineup.
- Properly utilizing the techniques and methods as taught by the instructor.

- Being aware of needs and taking the initiative to help.
- Communicating with the leadership to keep them informed of ongoing information (i.e. health conditions, absences, questions, concerns, etc.) that may directly affect my health and participation in NCJJ.
- Obeying the rules and leading by example.
- Accepting and following through with the consequences of breaking rules.
NOTE: Disciplinary actions will be at the discretion of the leaders. Consequences include, but are not limited to: sitting out, a loss of privileges, limited use of equipment, suspension and/or termination of membership.

LOVE

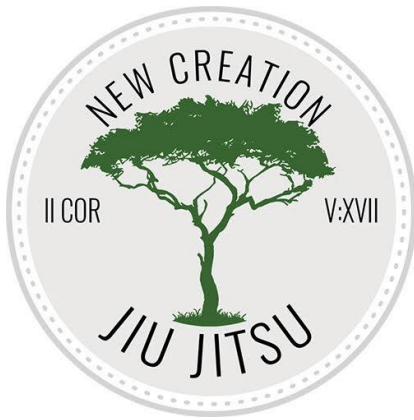
